MAYOR REPORTS:

Mayor Richard Zeck spoke briefly about the wreaths being noticed by the public, meals on wheels serves Simpson, each route requires 8 stops, due to several deaths in the past few months we are down to 3 residents, need to find more residents on the route before the route is lost. Christmas senior gift cards will go out soon, new fence will be going up at the park this week, new homes have started to be built by the post office, first new homes in Simpson in 26 years, issues with abandoned homes and multi-heir properties, working with a real estate attorney that will have something to present at January meeting on some proposals of ordinances to help clean up those properties. Donations will be sent to the churches and fire department and end the year in the black, results of the audit will be presented in January.
